The Applicant shall:

1. Be a student in a senior class of an accredited Virginia high school or home school program located in the counties of King William, New Kent, or King and Queen or located in the Town of West Point.
2. Plan to pursue a major in the performing arts in music (including voice), dance, or theatre, or music education.
3. Have been accepted to a college or university that offers a performing arts program and plan to major in that performing arts program.
4. Include an original plus a copy of your completed application.
5. Include a personal statement plus a copy by the applicant.
6. Request an official transcript of high school grades be mailed directly to the Arts Alive address of P.O. Box 906, West Point, VA 23181 by the high school in a sealed, stamped envelope.
7. Include two typed, signed, and sealed letters of recommendation.
8. Top applicants will be chosen for a personal interview. Applicants, if chosen, should be available to attend an audition on Sunday afternoon, **May 20, 2018 between 1 and 5 PM**. If unable to attend, properly labeled audition tapes of audition pieces meeting the audition requirements will be accepted by May 4, 2018 at 5 PM. Greater weight will be given to auditions in person.

***Award is made based on merit. Applications must be received by the coordinator on or before April 27, 2018 at 5 PM. The award must be used in the year in which it is granted, and will be paid directly to the educational institution.***
